

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is the agency responsible for curbside management operations within the District of Columbia. In pursuit of that responsibility, DDOT is preparing multiple solicitations for work that will support DDOT's curbside management efforts.

Prior to participating in DDOT's curbside management solicitations, interested vendors are asked to register their company with our Office of Contracts and Procurement (OCP), as well as our District Transportation Access Portal (DTAP). The process takes a few days to clear and approve registration, thus we strongly encourage interested vendors register at this time prior to the release of forthcoming solicitations. Forthcoming solicitations from DDOT would include:

- District-wide Curbside Asset Management Services – installing, operating, analyzing, and maintaining parking meters and curbside data collection equipment.
- District-wide Digital Parking Meter Services – installing signage, operating, analyzing, and maintaining digital parking meter services
- District-wide Curbside Permit Management Services – developing a system to consolidate disparate curbside management tools, datasets, and processes currently in place into one transparent, customer accessible, data driven, GIS centric system.
